

Prayer Request

Gospel for Asia (GFA) said Yashpal Bhuta Masih was detained in Madhya Pradesh after being "falsely accused" of violating India's "Freedom of Religion" statue that forbids conversions from "force, fraud or allurement."

Masih was taken into custody while leading three small congregations of 56 Christian converts, according to GFA investigators."Most of these new Christians are descendants of a tribe whose followers worship idols. Masih has a special burden for this tribe because his own father was a priest in their religion," GFA explained. Indian officials could not immediately be reached for comment.

Masih continues his work as a GFA missionary in a different town. GFA added in a statement, monitored by Worthy News, that its leaders asked Christians "to pray for justice to be done and that the Lord would grant Masih the strength to endure his upcoming trial." Worthynews.com

VATICAN CITY (AP) — An Austrian pastor who has been quoted as calling Hur-

ricane Katrina God's punishment for sin in New Orleans is being promoted to the rank if bishop.

The Vatican announced Saturday that Pope Benedict XVI has tapped the Rev. Gerhard Wagner, 54, to be auxiliary bishop in Linz, Austria. It made no mention of the reported remarks about Hurricane Katrina. Associatedpress.com

A Church in Trouble

GARDEN GROVE. Calif. - Once one of the most popular televangelists in the U.S., the Rev. Robert H. Schuller is watching his life's work crumble.

His son and recent successor, the Rev. Robert A. Schuller, has abruptly resigned as senior pastor of the Crystal Cathedral. The shimmering, glass-walled megachurch in Southern California is home to the "Hour of Power" broadcast, an evangelism staple that has been on the air worldwide for more than three decades.

The church is in financial turmoil: It plans to sell more than \$65 million worth of its Orange County property to pay off debt. Revenue dropped by nearly \$5 million last year, according to a recent letter from the elder Schuller to elite donors. In the letter, he implored the Eagle's Club members who supply 30 percent of the church's revenue — for donations and hinted that the show might go off the air without their support. It's a problem common to personality driven ministries. Members often tie their donations to the pastor, not the institution, said Nancy Ammerman, a sociologist of religion at Boston University. The church announced on Nov. 29 that Schuller Jr. had resigned as senior pastor, just a month after he was removed from the church's syndicated broadcasts. In a news release, Schuller Sr. said: "Robert and I have been struggling as we each have different ideas as to the direction and the vision for this ministry." Msnbc.om

Country Ribs



If you love ribs you will enjoy this recipe! Mouth watering, falling off the bone goodness is the best way to describe these succulent country style ribs. They are sure to have you running back for more! Enjoy!

1 cup Sweet red wine

1/2 cup Chili sauce

1/3 cup Vinegar

1/4 cup Honey

2 tablespoons Soy sauce

1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

2 teaspoons Salt

2 teaspoons Dry mustard

1 teaspoon Horseradish

1 teaspoon Red pepper sauce

1/2 teaspoon Ground pepper

1/2 teaspoon Paprika


3 tablespoons Vegetable oil

3 pounds Pork country-style ribs

Mix all ingredients except oil and ribs in saucepan. Heat to boiling, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Heat the oven to 350'. Heat the oil in Dutch oven over low heat. Brown half of the ribs in hot oil; remove ribs. Repeat with remaining ribs; drain off fat. Return ribs to Dutch oven; pour sauce over ribs. Cover and bake 1 hour. Uncover and bake until done, about 30 minutes. Remove ribs to serving bowl.


